Someone you know must drive you home. (No Taxi or Bus unless accompanied by someone). Bring the list of medications that you take. You can take approved medications at 6:00 AM with few sips of water. You may continue to drink <u>clear liquids only</u> until 4 hours **before** the procedure.

Someone you know must drive you home. (No Taxi/Uber or Bus unless accompanied by someone). Bring the list of medications that you take. You can take approved medications at 6:00 AM with few sips of water. You may continue to drink clear liquids only until 4 hours before the procedure. Please leave the valuables at home or with the person accompanying you. The facility is not responsible for any valuables brought to the facility. You may expect to spend approximately 2-3 hours from the time you check in to the time you leave. After the procedure, you are advised not to return to work, not drink alcohol, operate any machinery or not sign any important documents, rest of the day.
